

ORDINANCE 1985-2

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE PUBLIC DUMP, REGULATING THE ACCUMULATION AND DISPOSAL OF RUBBISH, TRASH AND REFUSE AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF

WHEREAS, the need to clarify the Towns Ordinances regarding public dumping and the accumulation and disposal of rubbish, trash and refuse has been recognized by the Board, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the health and safety of the residents of the Town that a uniform policy be adopted and that penalties be established regarding dumping and the accumulation and disposal of rubbish, trash and refuse.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TOWN TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF NEWBURGH, INDIANA:

Section 1: No person, firm or corporation shall throw, place or deposit, or cause to be thrown, placed or deposited in drains, sewers, ditches or gutters in the Town any limbs, leaves, cinders, ashes, waste matter or any obstruction of any kind.

Section 2: No person, firm or corporation shall haul, transport, or convey any trash, ashes, rubbish, refuse, junk or other discard or waste material, or cause the same to be hauled, transported or conveyed, and deposit, place or dump the same upon any public or private property in the Town of Newburgh; provided, however, that nothing in this Ordinance shall prohibit the dumping or depositing of dirt, sand or gravel, free of all trash, rubbish or refuse, upon any lot privately owned, at the request of the owner, for purposes of construction on said lot or the elevation of the grade of said lot.

Section 3: No person, firm or corporation shall haul or transport, or cause to be hauled or transported on the public streets and roadways of the Town any ashes, dirt, sand, rock, gravel rubbish, trash, discarded material or any loose material of any kind unless the same shall be in a tight box, cart, wagon or

truck so constructed or covered as to prevent the same from falling onto or becoming scattered upon the streets and roadways of the Town.

Section 4: The Warrick County Landfill, as maintained and located by Warrick County, is hereby designated as the public dump for use by the residents of the Town for the disposal of refuse.

Section 5: Nothing herein shall prohibit residents of the Town from placing trash at the street side for pickup by authorized trash collection agencies so long as the requirements for such trash pickup are met by such resident.

Section 6: Any person, firm or corporation who violates any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, for each such violation, be subject to an action for Ordinance enforcement including a civil penalty of not more than \$2500 dollars.

Section 7: All Ordinances and parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 8: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication as required by law.
