

## EXAMPLE OF CONTIGUOUS (ADJOINING) PROPERTY

Contiguous or adjoining property is defined as property which physically touches the subject property, or would physically touch the subject property except for the interposition of a street, alley, or other property owned by the applicant. This includes the corners of subject property.
